Course Description: During this course, current and past trends related to international, national, and state Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs will be covered along with the history of Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs and specific clubs throughout the United States, current conflicts with clubs at war with each other, and Gang membership/recruiting efforts. Identification of specific clubs and patches related to each gang and earned patches for specific crimes on behalf of the club. Finally, Officer safety tactics related to vehicle stops and contacts with OMG will be covered along with how to protect yourself and agency from lawsuits.

Location: River Lodge Conference Center- 1800 Riverwalk Drive, Fortuna (Humboldt County) CA.

Instructor(s): Lieutenant Brian Elmore is employed by the Sacramento Sheriff's Department and is assigned to the Central Patrol Division as a Watch Commander. He has been employed as a peace officer for over 30 years assigned as a Jail Training Officer, Field Training Officer, Generalist Detective, S.W.A.T. Team Leader, Firearms Instructor, Organized Crime/Vice Detective, Task Force Officer with the Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms, a Gang Detective, Patrol Sergeant and now Patrol Lieutenant. During his time as an investigator, he worked as a cover team member and in an undercover capacity in Outlaw Motorcycle Gang cases. For the past 19 years Lieutenant Elmore has been a member, Vice President and is currently the President of the Biker Investigators Association of Northern California, (B.I.A.N.C.A.). He has investigated gang shootings and homicides and testified as a Gang Expert in Outlaw Motorcycle Gang cases in 3 counties.
